

Travel in Africa seems to always include a challenge or two or three, and you have to hold on lightly to your plans and arrangements as they will change, often and without notice! That being said, our time in Tabora revealed a move of the Spirit that impacted both the lives of those attending the conference and the lives of those leading it. We averaged 125 pastors coming each day from the surrounding region to the new college campus. Western Bible College was established just last year and is still in construction. They have a critical need to find water on the property as several attempts to drill a well have failed to find water. We had three sessions each day. After each session of Robbie's teaching from Being Renewed, with AP Tanzania Director Ezekiel providing the interpretation into Swahili, as well as adding personal application, TAG Arch-Bishop, Dr. Barnabas Mtokumballi, would challenge his pastors to live in the truth of this teaching. The work of the Spirit brought about a breaking of pride and exposed the need for repentance, restitution, and renewal in the lives of the pastors. On Thursday we washed the feet of several of the pastors and it brought about an outpouring of repentance and embracing the truth of cleansing and renewal in the grace and forgiveness of God. These pastors were not going to leave in the same condition they arrived! God is so good! We finished up in Tabora and have traveled to Mwanza and are now in the middle of a new conference, teaching the material to a new group of Pastors gathered at Lake Victoria Bible College. God is moving again in a powerful way. Keep praying!
